



ARABIC LUTHERAN MINISTRIES 2018 END OF THE YEAR REPORT

Life is made up of a special moments and events that we will never forget. Perhaps one of the most powerful moments in our lives is our Baptism, in which God, in Christ, claims us as His Children. As a New Creature in Christ our life is full of life changing events that help us *“become in every respects the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ. From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work (Ephesians 4: 15-16). And while we grow, we “Always give thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ” (Ephesians 5: 20).*

In this issue we would like to share with you some of the 2018 moments in the life of our Ministry. As we write this report to our partners in the gospel the Lord remind us of the joy that Paul experienced;

Our Ministries Move to St Louis...

In the Fall of 2017 Dr. Bahkou, the director of ALM, accepted a call to serve as Associate Professor of Practical Theology at Concordia Seminary Saint Louis. When he moved to the Saint Louis area in 2018, the president of Concordia Seminary, Dr. Dale Meyer and the LCMS National and International Mission Office, encouraged Dr. Bahkou to continue his ministries among Arabs and Muslims. Dr. Bahkou began contacting mission societies in the Saint-Louis area to learn



of the local need which was great. Our first meeting of Arabic Lutheran Ministries, St Louis was held at the Bahkou home in Fenton, Missouri. We were excited to find a group of like-minded believers that are dedicated to help in the mission of ALM.

Since Dr. Bahkou and his family relocated in Saint Louis area, many churches and mission organizations have contacted us to partner with them. In August of 2018, Abiding Savior Lutheran Church in Saint Louis invited Dr. Bahkou to help with a special Vacation Bible School that the church had organized for immigrants in Saint Louis area. Over 15 Syrian and Jordanian immigrants, with their families attended the 2 day VBS and Dr. Bahkou shared the Gospel with them in Arabic.

Mission to Gambia...

In the summer of 2018 Dr. John Loum our Chairman of the Board, who is the Director of Ethnic Immigrant Institute of Theology at Concordia Seminary in Saint Louis, and missionary to Gambia, has asked Dr. Bahkou to join him in his mission trip to Gambia. The reason because Dr. Bahkou is an expert in Mission to Muslims. Gambia is 93% Muslims. In 2019 the country will host the International Conference of Islamic States which represents 49 Nations and 1.6 billion Muslims.



The purpose of this mission trip was to encourage our Lutheran Churches in Gambia to seize this unique opportunity to reach out to Muslims with the Good News of the Gospel. Members and leaders of our Lutheran Churches need to be equipped and encouraged for this task.

The second purpose of this trip was equipping pastors and missionaries on how to use the Luther Catechism and the Book of Concord to teach and equip believers. Dr. Bahkou spent 2 weeks in Gambia (November 4th -17th 2018).

Trip to Sweden...

Through our Media ministry we are reaching all over the world with our Lutheran teachings; Pastors, missionaries and lay people from all over the world contact us for partnership, invitation to train leaders and teach.

Dr. Bahkou was contacted by different mission ministries in Europe who expressed their desire to partner with our Arabic Lutheran Ministries, and invited him to teach and plan for leadership training seminars all over Europe.



On November 23, Dr. Bahkou gave a spiritual talk at the Arabic gathering in Stockholm, Sweden. More than 150 Arabs from different denominations attended. There was also an opportunity to distribute and sign *Life with God*, which is an Arabic Discipleship program, based on Luther's Small Catechism, published by our Ministry and written by Dr. Bahkou.

The Need...

Last year through the generous donation of The Roy D. and Ingaborg G. Randolph Memorial Endowment Fund we were able to professionally film and edit over 30 teaching segments of Rev. Dr. Abjar Bahkou. These sermons are posted on our Website, YouTube channel, and Facebook. They are also being broadcast on International Satellites that reach millions all over the world, especially the Arab World. This is an ongoing ministry. Every week we are recording, editing and publishing segments to be broadcast.

The second need is to train Arabic Speaking pastors and church planters, locally here in America and globally all over the world. The need is to translate the curriculums used by our seminaries to train pastors, in Arabic.
